

KOINOS PRAYER ON 1st Friday of Dec 2011

Leaders to read this devotion to members before worship time.

A pastor was asked to call on a woman in a psychiatric hospital and pray for her. After his visit, he thought how good it would be for somebody to go there regularly and pray for the residents. The “somebody” turned out to be him. On a table in one of the wards, he put up a sign saying “Free Prayer.” Later he recalled, “Suddenly I had 15 people standing in line to get prayed for.”

People often ask for our prayers, but do we faithfully pray for them? Many times we see others in great need but find it easier to discuss their plight with friends rather than to intercede for them. But people need and want our prayers.

Paul concluded his call to put on “the whole armor of God” (Ephesians 6:13-17) by writing, “Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints” (v.18).

Oswald Chambers often referred to prayer as “the ministry of the interior” and said, “There is no snare, or any danger of infatuation or pride in intercession; it is a hidden ministry that brings forth fruit whereby the Father is glorified.”

Faithful prayer—whether in public or private—is one of the greatest gifts we can give others.

To give to others what they need,
We show no greater care
Than when we give them to the Lord,
Upholding them in prayer. —D. De Haan

Our intercession may be the key to God's intervention.

Koinos Leader & members preparation

1. To fast one meal for the day.
2. To break fast for dinner at koinos venue after worship and prayer session end. *We do not recommend eating in between prayer or before prayer time during koinos time. This will divert the prayer focus.*
3. Food for dinner can be potbless or other arrangement.
4. In view of fasting, koinos prayer can start 30-40 minutes earlier.
5. Leaders, please plan carefully with members about fasting a meal. Skipping dinner and having dinner later after prayer is not CONSIDERED fasting, it is delayed meal time.

KOINOS AGENDA FOR PRAYER

1. Worship (20 – 30 minutes)

Have 20-30 minutes worship session & flow in the spirit. Koinos Worship leaders to prepare songs that relate to prayers and launching into prayer.
2. Proceed to prayer item.
3. Sing another worship song to move into koinos group prayer item. (5 minutes)
4. Koinos group prayer items :- (20 – 30 minutes)
 - a. Prayer need to flow one after another without interruption. Pre-delegate the prayer request to various individuals before worship start.
 - b. Leaders can work with worship leader to lead in a song in between 2 prayer request to help members to focus.
 - c. End the koinos group prayers with a affirmative worship songs of victory, hope or joy.

Prayer items

i. NATION

a. Pray for the coming General Election.

- God to direct the right timing.
- For good and capable candidates to be elected in.
- Fair, Righteous election and fully participated by every voter.

b. Pray for FREEDOM IN MALAYSIA OF...

- Racial Prejudices in our country. Majority raced politics.
- Corrupt practices in govt and private practice
- Religious worship and practices

ii. Pray for the irregulars and newcomer to attend koinos

Pray for newcomers and irregulars who have yet to attend koinos to be receptive and willing to join your koinos meeting. (*Leaders please list of names prior to the prayer time*)

iii. Koinos leaders & Ministry

a. Pray for your koinos leader and all the rest of the koinos leaders ask for God's anointing, passion and gifting to arise from each and everyone. That God will bless the in their business, career, family and spiritual life.

b. Pray for the koinos ministry, Zone Pastor, zone leaders, koinos leaders to flow with the spirit of the Lord to lead us to strategically to press on to the next level for 2012.

Break into groups of 2-3 to pray for the following:-

i. Pray for unsaved family members and relatives

Pray that God will touch their heart and set them free from the bondage of other God's, materialism, unbelief, indifference and spiritual blindness.

Plead for divine intervention upon the situation and circumstances in their life. (Pray for them by names)

ii. Pray for koinos member's own career, business and family life or any needs or struggles that require God's divine intervention.
