Topic : **God Hears Prayers**  
Scripture Text : Psalm 18:6

Rev. Cornelio & Deborah have just returned from China & they have witnessed great miracles of God there & also when they ministered to Indian Apache tribes.

- Mark 5 talked of the healing virtues of God. It is still evident today because Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. (Heb. 13:8)
- Isaiah 53:5 = "But he was pierced for our transgressions. He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, by His wounds we are healed."
- Exodus 15:26 = "...I am the Lord, who heals you "He is Jehovah Ropha".

Psalm 18:6 = "I call to the Lord, who is worthy of praise and I am saved from my enemies."

- Every time we come into the Presence of God, anticipate a change because He comes to change us.
- It is said that God puts his "super" on our 'natural' & it becomes **supernatural, through His power.**
- God sits on the throne that governs everything and one word from Him can bring change to our whole destiny, no matter how insurmountable the circumstances/obstacles may look.
- When God hears your prayers, change is on the way. When we speak, we are heard in 2 realms: we speak from the **earth** & God hears us in **heaven.**
- We are now living in the end times & nothing can stop the outpouring of the Holy Spirit & revelation of the awesomeness of His glory.
- Matt. 16: 18b = "...the gates of Hades will not overcome it."
- Zech. 12:10 = "And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication. They will look on him, and the one they have pierced, and they will mourn for him as one mourns for an only child, and grieve bitterly for him who grieves for the a firstborn son."

- When we pray in the Spirit of God, praying will not be boring & it will be a time of joy in the Presence of the Lord.
- Daniel 6 = We must all have the tenacity & spirit of Daniel. Even though Daniel was in the lion's den, he refused to be compromised or back off **and God's awesomeness & glory was revealed.**

- **Know that Our God is Jehovah Shalom, the God of Peace: He is the "Peace who has broken down every wall..." Alleluia!**
